UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA LEADER OF TOMORROW AND INDIGENOUS LEADER OF TOMORROW SCHOLARSHIPS

Grade 12 students are invited to apply for either one of these \$16000 scholarships which are based on achieving over 90% in the following grade 11 courses: English, Math (Pre-Calculus), and the highest mark in three of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, History, Geography or a language at the 30S level.
