For those students wanting to know what their averages are, follow this simple formula: add up the total of all of your marks and divide by the number of credits. Remember that you must divide your mark in half if it is a half credit course. **Example:** Math 85% + Science 90%, + Art 95% (47.5) + Phys Ed 85% = 307.5 divided by 3.5 credits = 87.86% average
