MATH ASSISTANCE (GRADE 9)

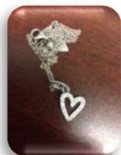

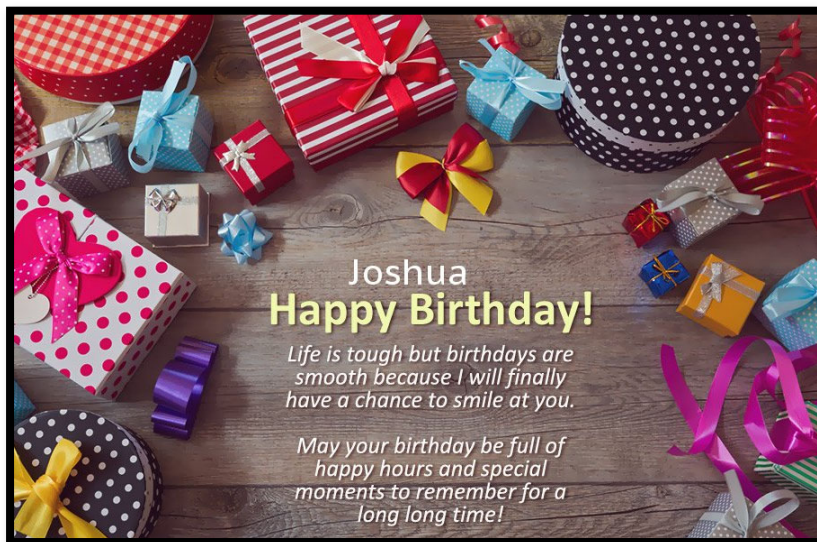
ATHLETICS
