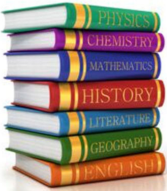
- 1) The only change allowed in the dress code is being able to wear sweats instead of jeans or dress pants. This revision in the dress code is similar to sweatpants Fridays.
